Make a bird kebab

Make this tasty snack for birds to nibble on!

You will need: floral wire, string, bird food such as apples, bread, hard cheese and raisins.

1. Choose the food you want to use and cut into marble-sized chunks and pieces.
2. Carefully thread each piece into floral wire, leaving around 8cm at either end.

Bend the ends into hooks.

3. Bend the wire to form a circle and hook the ends together.

4. Tie some string on the wire circle and hang your kebab outside for the birds to snack on.

You can take it down once it's empty and refill with more food.
